



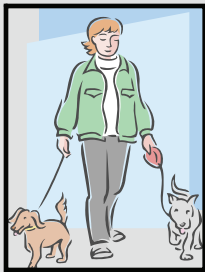

General Community Information

The **pool** opens the Saturday of Memorial Day weekend!! Make sure you get your application in prior to the start date!

Swim Team information will be available at the pool, including practice times and the swim meet schedule.

Exterior Changes - If you plan to make exterior changes to your home or property, please submit an ARC application prior to starting any work (email to hoa@haydenvillage.org is preferred) with all appropriate sketches, drawings, and other scanned brochures and product information as appropriate. Applications can be found online at www.haydenvillage.org.

Please **prune and trim** any bushes or trees that overhang sidewalks, pipestems, streets, etc. People with umbrellas should be able to comfortably pass beneath and next to trees and shrubs.

The Board will be working with a vendor in the coming months to review all the **common area trees** and make a plan for removing dead or dying trees, major pruning, etc. for the coming months.

Also, please remember to pick up after your **pets**. As a community we seem to have ongoing problems with this. It is a Fairfax County law that you pick up after your pet.

The board has heard from several residents about the possibility of posting advertisements on the webpage (www.haydenvillage.org).

We would like to offer the ability to have residents only submit advertisements for services—such as lawn mowing, babysitting, pet sitting, home businesses, etc. on the webpage. A form will be developed and included on the website for you to fill in and submit to hoa@haydenvillage.org.

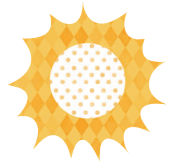
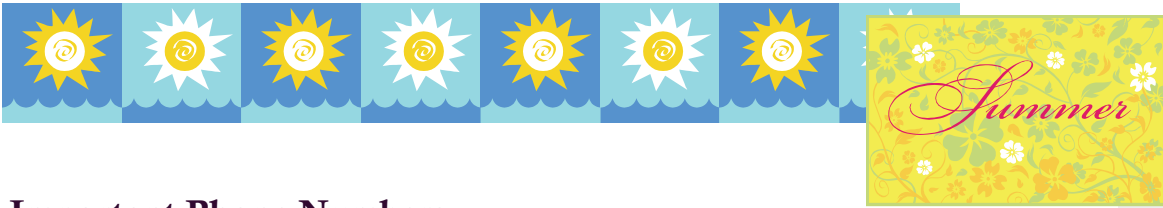

Postings for services would be for a 3-month period and for sale or give away items 1-month. The posted items would be updated once a week.

This service would be maintained by volunteers and done as quickly as possible, and with the understanding that this is a service for community residents only.
